

## Addendum 2008-6

# LANDSCAPE GUIDELINES

On June 10, 2008, Lake Arrowhead Community Services District adopted ordinance No. 69. One of the provisions of that ordinance specifically states that a property owner may only irrigate their property per LACSD regulations, not ALA property or other adjacent land. As a result, ALA will consider only the following plant list that can be established with proper planting, mulching, and minimal manual watering on ALA property. A landscape plan with fire safe and natural spacing to create a forest like setting will be required and may include:

### **CONIFERS:**

White Fir	Abies concolor
Incense Cedar	Calocedrus decurrens
Coulter Pine	Pinus coulteri
Jeffrey Pine	Pinus jeffreyi
Sugar Pine	Pinus lambertiana
Ponderosa Pine	Pinus ponderosa
Bigcone Doug-Fir	Pseudotsuga macrocarpa*

### **BROADLEAF:**

Black Oak	Quercus kelloggii	Deciduous
Canyon Live Oak	Quercus chrysolepis	
Interior Live Oak	Quercus wislizeni	

### **SHRUBS:**

Four-Wing Saltbush	Atriplex canescens
Manzanita variety	Arctostaphylos densiflora 'HowardMcMinn'
Cotoneaster varieties	Cotoneaster spp.
Oregon Grape	Mahonia aquifolium
Coffeeberry	Rhamnus californica
California Bay	Umbellularia californica*

### **ACCENT PLANTS** (plant sparingly):

Western Redbud	Cercis occidentalis	Deciduous small tree
Pacific Dogwood	Cornus nuttallii**	Deciduous small tree
Cinquefoil	Potentilla fruticosa	Shrubby perennial
Wild Rose	Rosa californica	Deciduous
Russian Sage	Perovskia var.	Shrubby perennial
Deer Grass	Muhlenbergia rigens	Perennial
Yarrow	Achillea spp.	Perennial

**NOTE:** Removal of Daffodil bulbs and Flowering Plum from the approved Accent Plant list **IS NOT RETROACTIVE.** Existing plants may remain as part of your landscaping.

### **GROUNDCOVERS** (limited areas):

Kinnikinnick	Arctostaphylos uva-ursi
Evening Primrose	Oenothera spp.

\*Not advised in windy areas

\*\*Best in protected areas with some shade and natural moisture
