

SIDE-TIE POLICY

Approved by the ALA Board of Directors July 26, 2014

ALA does not consider side-tied boats to be legally moored. Legal mooring for a boat is considered to be one boat inside a slip.

ALA allows side-tied boats only as long as no complaints from adjacent dock owners are received and only as long as the slip is not being rented. If a complaint from an adjacent dock owner is received, the side-tied boat must be removed from the lake. If the slip is rented and the slip owner or renter is side-tying their boat to the outside of the dock, the side-tied boat is not allowed and must be removed from the lake.
