**SUBJECT:** Lake Arrowhead Community Services District Correspondence

**SYNOPSIS:**

Correspondence has been received regarding the installation of irrigation meters to serve Arrowhead Lake Association property irrigated by members.

**BACKGROUND:**

Lake Arrowhead Community Services District Ordinance 69 prohibits LACSD ratepayers from irrigating property that they do not own. LACSD has recognized that there are some situations with mitigating circumstances and in considering the installation of "Irrigation Meters" for those situations. Such meters would be billed at a rate consistent with CLAWA rates paid by LACSD and the water metered through such meters would be provided from sources other than Lake Arrowhead.

ALA's past position has been to discourage the irrigation of our property by members and not to allow the installation of new permanent irrigation systems in support of the conservation efforts of LACSD. This proposal from LACSD would only be effective if such systems met certain requirements (to be determined by ALA) and were maintained in good working order.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is the recommendation of staff that this matter be referred to the Forest Planning Committee for the formulation of a response to Lake Arrowhead Community Services District.
