Arrowhead Lake Association 2021 Fishing Derby Rules

- Saturday, May 29, 2021
- Check In: 5:30 AM at the ALA Marina (Membership card required)
- Start Time: 6:00 AM
- **Weigh-In Schedule:**
 - Trout 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM
 - Bass 11:00 AM (will move to the front of the line)
- Derby Categories:
 1. Trout - Adult (Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place)
 2. Bass - Adult (Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place) **(special rules apply - see below)**
 3. Youth - (Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place)
 4. Biggest Fish - Adult
 5. Biggest Fish - Youth
- One or two person teams ONLY **(ALA Members and their guests)**
- Rod and Reel ONLY
- All state regulations apply. All participants 16 and older must show current CA Fishing License at registration
- Winners determined by heaviest stringer of five (5) fish for both Trout and Bass

Rules For Teams Fishing For Bass

1. Insofar as possible, all fish shall be returned to the water alive and in good condition
2. All contestants shall have facilities for keeping Bass alive and in good condition
3. Only artificial lures may be used
4. Bass shall be transported to and from the vessel to the weigh-in site in water-filled containers with sufficient water to cover the fish, except during the actual measuring/weighing process. Individual Bass over approximately 5 lbs. shall be held in separate containers both before and after weighing. Fish shall be held in water filled containers no longer than three (3) minutes prior to or after the weigh-in unless the water in that container is replenished. All Bass shall be released immediately after weigh-in. Bass shall not be towed to the release site in devices made of mesh or netting to prevent the fish from being impinged upon by the mesh.
