WHAT IS THE ARROWHEAD LAKE ASSOCIATION TROUT TRIFECTA CHALLENGE?

An annual program designed for Arrowhead Lake Association (ALA) members, their families, and guests to encourage anglers to learn more about the three species of trout that are stocked in Lake Arrowhead, CA. under the direction of the ALA Fish Committee.

What you do:

- Go fishing and catch all three species of trout (Brown, Lightning, and Rainbow) found in Lake Arrowhead. Take a weekend, a summer, or all year to complete.
- Take a photo of each fish. You do not have to be in the picture and size of the fish doesn't matter. Please be sure pictures are clear enough for species identification.
- Complete the application form and submit along with photo of each fish. The application asks for location of caught fish such as Emerald Bay, Peninsula Pier, middle of the lake, etc. Send to trouttrifecta@ala-ca.org. or bring into the ALA office during normal business hours.
- What we do:
- Once we receive documentation, our experts will review and a color certificate will be issued recognizing your achievement. Each angler will be issued only one certificate per year April 1 through March 31. All applications remain the property of ALA.
- Your name will be listed in the Arrowhead Lake Association Trout Trifecta Challenge Hall of Fame.
